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2018 STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME & STATIONERY LISTS

Dear Parents/Carers,

In accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, the cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of students enrolled at state schools who are (or are children of) Australian citizens or permanent residents, is met by the State.

Parents/carers are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other personal resources for their children while attending school. As a service to assist parents with the cost of these educational resources, our school operates a **Student Resource Scheme (SRS)** endorsed by the P&C Association.

The Student Resource Scheme provides for

- Textbooks personal issue and class sets
- Library books including home readers
- Computer software
- Learning materials for every subject used in classes
- Reproduced class materials which complement and/or substitute for textbooks
- Materials to extend instruction through practical learning experiences
- Access to the materials and resources outlined in the attached 2018 Subject Requirements List

Items NOT provided by the Student Resource Scheme

- Optional school activities such as excursions, incursions, camps and performances.
- Items outlined in the Stationery Lists
- Swimming & other sporting events outside of the school
- Instrumental Music (a separate Instrumental Music SRS applies)

Is the Student Resource Scheme compulsory?

- NO, participation is voluntary, and there is no obligation on a parent / carer to participate in it.
- However, parents who choose not to participate are expected to supply their children with the resources on the attached **2018 Subject Requirements List.**

Cost of the Student Resource Scheme

- The cost of the SRS in 2018 will be \$80 per child or \$160 per family (excluding Prep Students).
- Prep students are excluded from the family discount due to the heavy resource load in Prep. It follows that families with 3 or more children can expect to pay a total of \$160 if they don't have a student in Prep or \$240 (\$80 Prep levy + \$160 family levy) if they do.

How do I participate in the Student Resource Scheme?

- Make an informed decision whether to participate in the scheme or not
- Indicate **NO** or **YES** on the attached Participation Agreement Form (green sheet) and return the form to the Office as soon as possible. **Every family** should complete and return the form.
- Make the required payment in full or in accordance with the payment plan outlined on the agreement form.
- Invoices will be issued in Term 1, 2018 to families who have returned their signed "Participation Agreement Forms".
- Payment may be made at any time, but is not required until Term 1, 2018.
- The account for the scheme must be finalised by the end of Term 3, 2018.

Payment Methods

- Payment can be made by cash, cheque, EFTPOS, BPOINT or Direct Deposit.

- Refunds will need to be requested and approved by the Principal in accordance with school policy.

- 2018 Stationery Lists were given to students in week 8.
